8 SYNOPSIS: This bill amends Section 32-2-84, Code of
9 Alabama 1975, to provide that funds transferred
10 from the Public Road and Bridge Fund of the
11 Department of Transportation to the Department of
12 Public Safety, which will become part of the
13 Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, pursuant to
14 Act 91-797 may be expended for the operations of
15 the Department of Public Safety.

21 To amend Section 32-2-84, Code of Alabama 1975, to
22 provide that funds transferred from the Public Road and Bridge
23 Fund of the Department of Transportation to the Department of
24 Public Safety, which will become part of the Alabama State Law
25 Enforcement Agency, pursuant to Act 91-797 may be expended for
26 the operations of the Department of Public Safety.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Section 32-2-84 is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 "§32-2-84.

4 The funds designated by this article to be deposited
5 to the Motor Vehicle Replacement Fund are intended to be in
6 addition to the amounts transferred annually to the Department
7 of Public Safety from the Public Road and Bridge Fund pursuant
8 to Act 91-797. ~~For fiscal years ending September 30, 2011,~~
9 ~~2012, 2013 and 2014, funds~~ Funds transferred to the Department
10 of Public Safety, which will become part of the Alabama State
11 Law Enforcement Agency, pursuant to Act 91-797 may be expended
12 for the operations of the department ~~Effective October 1,~~
13 ~~2014, funds transferred to the Department of Public Safety~~
14 ~~pursuant to Act 91-797 shall be expended~~ as well as for the
15 purchase of equipment for traffic law enforcement, as provided
16 by that act. Such equipment shall include motor vehicles and
17 related equipment only.

18 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
19 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
20 unconstitutional, such declaration shall not affect the part
21 that remains.

22 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
23 with this act are hereby repealed.

25 Section 4. This bill shall become effective
26 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor or
27 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
