13 Relating to Walker County; to provide that the judge  
14 of probate shall provide for an additional method of ordering  
15 annual certificates for registration of boats by mail; to  
16 provide an additional fee to the boat owner for each  
17 certificate issued by mail; and to provide for the disposition  
18 of the fee.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. The Walker County Judge of Probate shall  
21 mail forms to all registered boat owners within the county to  
22 allow boat owners to complete such application forms for  
23 ordering the annual certificate of registration and pay for  
24 any taxes and tags or decals by mail so that the tag or decal  
25 and receipts therefor may be forwarded to the owner by mail.  
26 There is hereby established a fee of two dollars (\$2) to be  
27 entitled "Mail Order Fee" which shall be set from time to time

1 by the county governing body to pay the cost of the mailing  
2 procedure herein provided, and such fee shall be collected by  
3 the judge of probate at the time of issuance and paid over to  
4 the general fund of the county as are other fees and  
5 commissions.

6 Section 2. The provisions of this act are cumulative  
7 and shall not be construed to repeal or supersede any laws or  
8 parts of laws not directly inconsistent herewith.

9 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
10 first day of the third month following its passage and  
11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
