Section 2. There is appropriated from the Insurance Department Fund in the State Treasury to the Department of Insurance the sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. Of this amount, up to two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) may be transferred by the Commissioner of Insurance to the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund established pursuant to Section 27-31E-2, Code of Alabama 1975. The appropriation made in this section is in addition to any and all other funds heretofore or hereafter appropriated to the Department of Insurance.

Section 3. There is appropriated from the Strengthen Alabama Homes Fund in the State Treasury established pursuant to Section 27-31E-2, Code of Alabama 1975, to the Department of Insurance the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016. The appropriation made in this section is in addition to any and all other funds heretofore or hereafter appropriated to the Department of Insurance.

Section 4. This act shall be effective January 1, 2016.
