8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to St.
10 Clair County, to authorize the Legislature to fix,
11 alter, and regulate court costs in the county and
12 provide for their distribution.

18 Relating to St. Clair County; proposing an amendment
19 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the
20 Legislature to fix, alter, and regulate court costs in the
21 county and provide for their distribution.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. The following amendment to the
24 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
25 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
26 this act are fulfilled:

1 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

2 The Legislature, by general or local law, may fix,
3 alter, and regulate the costs and charges of courts in St.
4 Clair County and provide for their distribution.

5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
6 shall be held at the next election in the county held in
7 accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama
8 of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official
9 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
10 amended, and the election laws of this state.

11 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
12 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
13 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
14 following description of the substance or subject matter of
15 the proposed constitutional amendment:

16 "Relating to St. Clair County; proposing an
17 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize
18 the Legislature to fix, alter, and regulate court costs in the
19 county and provide for their distribution.

20 "Proposed by Act _____."

21 This description shall be followed by the following
22 language:

23 "Yes () No ()."
