10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT

13 To alter or rearrange the boundary lines of the City
14 of Alexander City, Tallapoosa County, Alabama, so as to
15 include within the corporate limits of said City all territory
16 now within such corporate limits and also certain other
17 territory contiguous thereto, in Alexander City, Tallapoosa
18 County, Alabama.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. That the boundary lines of the City of
21 Alexander City, Tallapoosa County, Alabama, be, and the same
22 are hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the
23 territory heretofore encompassed by the corporate limits of
24 the City of Alexander City, and in addition thereto the
25 following described territory, to-wit:

26 IN TOWNSHIP 23 NORTH, RANGE 21 EAST, TALLAPOOSA
27 COUNTY, ALABAMA

17 Section 2. A map showing the territory proposed to
18 be annexed is on file in the Dadeville and Alexander City,
19 Alabama offices of the Judge of Probate in Tallapoosa County.
20 This map is open to public inspection. A copy of said map or
21 plat shall also be retained for public inspection at the City
22 Clerk's office at the Alexander City City Hall.

23 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon its
24 passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise
25 becoming a law.
