BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 9-11-72 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

8 \$9-11-72.

A violation of any rule of the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources prohibiting the transportation and release of live feral swine shall be a Class B misdemeanor punishable as provided by law, except the defendant shall be subject to a mandatory minimum fine of not less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each day the feral swine have been released.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
