8	SYNOPSIS:	This bill would prohibit the possession or
9		sale of sky lanterns, which are defined as
10		free-floating luminary lanterns with an open flame
11		inside. A violation would be a criminal violation
12		punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200.
13		Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama
14		of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
15		Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
16		Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general
17		law whose purpose or effect would be to require a
18		new or increased expenditure of local funds from
19		becoming effective with regard to a local
20		governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote

22		specified exceptions; it is approved by the
23		affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates
24		funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to

9 AN ACT

Relating to fire safety; to prohibit the possession or sale of sky lanterns; to provide penalties; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section, a "sky lantern" means an unmanned self-contained free-floating luminary device requiring an open flame underneath, such as a candle, for propulsion.

(b) It shall be unlawful to possess, sell at retail, offer to sell at retail, distribute, or give away a sky lantern in this state. 1 (c) A violation of this section is a criminal 2 violation punishable pursuant to Section 13A-5-12, Code of 3 Alabama 1975.

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621 because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
