A BILL

10 TO BE ENTITLED

11 AN ACT

13 Relating to Covington County; to require future
14 members of the county board of education to reside within, and
15 be elected by the qualified electors of the county who reside
16 within, that portion of the county outside of the corporate
17 limits of any city in the county served by a separate city
18 board of education.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the next term of
21 office, each member of the Covington County Board of
22 Education, at the time of qualifying for office and during the
23 entire term of office, shall reside within that portion of the
24 county lying outside of the corporate limits of any city in
25 the county served by a separate city board of education, and
26 shall be elected by the qualified electors who reside within
27 that portion of the county.

(b) Nothing in this section shall affect the unexpired term of any member serving on the board on the effective date of this section.

(c) The appropriate election officials shall conduct elections of members of the Covington County Board of Education in conformity with this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
