17	Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section, a
18	"sky lantern" means an unmanned self-contained free-floating
19	luminary device requiring an open flame underneath, such as a
20	candle, for propulsion.
21	(b) It shall be unlawful to possess, sell at retail,
22	offer to sell at retail, distribute, or give away a sky
23	lantern in this state.
24	(c) A violation of this section is a criminal
25	violation punishable pursuant to Section 13A-5-12, Code of
26	Alabama 1975.

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621 because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
