2.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Effective for taxes collected after the ratification of this amendment, the proceeds of any ad valorem tax levied in Pickens County pursuant to Amendment No. 649, as amended by Amendment No. 765, of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 6 of the Pickens County Local Amendments of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, distributed to volunteer fire departments for fire protection purposes, in addition to being used for fire protection purposes, may be used for emergency medical purposes by a volunteer fire department in the county, including, but not limited to, for the purchase of medical equipment, rescue equipment, and medical supplies and otherwise for the delivery of emergency medical services.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held at the general election in 2022 in accordance with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
