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8 Relating to motor vehicle registration receipt forms
9 and validation decals; to add Section 32-6-64.2 to the Code of
10 Alabama 1975; to allow a county licensing official to contract
11 with a third party, upon approval of the county commission, to
12 provide materials for print-on-demand validation decals,
13 emblems, and registration receipt forms; to provide that
14 amounts distributed to the Department of Corrections shall not
15 be reduced by such contracts; and to provide that such
16 contracts are subject to the procurement provisions of the
17 county.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Section 32-6-64.2 is added to the Code of
20 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

21 §32-6-64.2.

22 (a) In lieu of being supplied validation decals,
23 emblems, and registration receipt forms directly from the
24 Department of Corrections or the Department of Revenue, county
25 licensing officials may contract with a third party, upon
26 approval by the county commission, to provide materials for
27 print-on-demand validation decals, emblems, and registration

1 receipt forms. The validation decals, emblems, and
2 registration receipt forms shall be subject to review and
3 approval by the Department of Revenue to ensure statewide
4 uniformity.

5 (b) The amount distributed to the Department of
6 Corrections pursuant to this chapter, including Section
7 32-6-64.1, or any other provision of law, shall not be reduced
8 by any contract entered into by a county licensing official
9 pursuant to this section, nor shall any contract entered into
10 pursuant to this section be interpreted to apply to or extend
11 to registrations issued under Chapter 5 of Title 33.

12 (c) Contracts entered into pursuant to this section
13 shall be subject to the procurement requirements of the
14 licensing official's county.

15 (d) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules for
16 the implementation and administration of this section.

17 Section 2. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
