23	municipality in the county that has its own separate city

27	Board of Education on the effective date of this section.

- 1 (b) If a new city school system is established
 2 within Baldwin County, the Baldwin County Board of Education
 3 shall redraw current single member election districts pursuant
 4 to Section 16-8-1, Code of Alabama 1975, to account for the
 5 creation of the new city school system.
 - (c) The provisions of this section are supplemental and shall be construed in pari materia with all other laws relating to the Baldwin County Board of Education.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
