22	Section 1. Section 23 of Act 79-524, 1979 Regular
23	Session (Acts 1979, p. 935), as amended, is amended to read as
24	follows:
25	"Section 23. All expenses incurred in the
26	implementation of the provisions of this act shall be financed
7	from a special fund provided in the county treasury for such

purposes, pursuant to the passage of an additional tax on the sales of beer, malt, or brewed beverages in Shelby County at the 1977 Regular Session of the Legislature. It is further provided, however, that expenditures by the board in one year shall not exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) two hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$275,000) derived from the proceeds of the tax. Any income derived from the proceeds of the tax, which exceeds the actual expenditures of the board for any year, shall be paid over to the county general fund and shall be used exclusively by the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement purposes in the county."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
