SYNOPSIS:

This bill would authorize the Governor to appoint honorary generals to serve in the Alabama National Guard and provide for their duties.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama National Guard; to authorize the Governor to appoint honorary generals and provide for their duties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Honorary generals in the Alabama National Guard may be appointed by the Governor, upon recommendation of the Adjutant General and subject to confirmation by the Senate. Each appointee shall be an Alabama National Guard officer with a minimum of 25 years of service who has retired at the rank of colonel.

(b) An honorary general may wear the National Guard uniform with the insignia of rank of one star. An honorary general may represent the Governor at certain military functions and as otherwise directed by the Adjutant General.

(c) An honorary general shall receive no other benefit

30 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first
31 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
32 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
