1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Pickens County; to provide for a new court
4 cost to pay for service of process by the sheriff of documents
5 filed in the district and circuit courts in Pickens County;
6 and to deposit the proceeds into the Pickens County Sheriff's
7 Law Enforcement Fund.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. This act shall apply to Pickens County.

10 Section 2. (a) (1) In addition to all other court costs
11 authorized in Pickens County, a service of process fee of
12 twenty-five dollars (\$25) shall be collected for service or
13 attempted service of process on each document requiring
14 personal service of process by the sheriff in all cases filed
15 or pending in the district court or the circuit court of
16 Pickens County.

17 (2) The service fee collected by the circuit court
18 clerk for a case filed or pending in either court shall be
19 distributed as follows:

20 a. Five dollars (\$5) to the circuit clerk's Judicial
21 Administration Fund.

22 b. Twenty dollars (\$20) to the Sheriff's Law
23 Enforcement Fund for the law enforcement purposes of the
24 sheriff's office.

25 (3) The State of Alabama, its political subdivisions,
26 and their instrumentalities are exempt from this cost.

27 (b) The fees deposited into the Sheriff's Law
28 Enforcement Fund are in addition to, and do not diminish,

29 offset, or take the place of any other cost or fee that is
30 disbursed to the sheriff or the county jail.

31 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
32 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
33 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
