A BILL

TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

9 To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year
10 ending September 30, 2023, from the Opioid Treatment and
11 Abatement Fund to the entities and for the purposes herein in
12 the amount of \$10,000,000.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Opioid
15 Treatment and Abatement Fund the sum of \$10,000,000 for the
16 fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, to the entities and for
17 the purposes specified herein.

23 (2) To the Department of Mental Health to establish a
24 competitive grant program for community providers that provide
25 opioid prevention, treatment, medication, and services to
26 individuals and families that have a proven positive outcome
27 on individuals and families suffering from opioid addiction,
28 \$8,500,000.



29 Section 2. All funds appropriated in this act not
30 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, shall
31 not revert, but shall be carried forward for the purpose
32 appropriated.

33 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately
34 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
35 otherwise becoming law.
