8 AN ACT

10 Relating to education; to require a public K-12 school,
11 a local board of education, and certain event organizers to
12 accept certain forms of payment for admission to certain
13 school-sponsored events.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. (a) A public K-12 school or a local board of
16 education shall accept cash as a form of payment along with
17 any other form of payment of its choosing for admission to
18 school-sponsored sporting events that are open to the public.

19 (b) All events that are open to the public, feature at
20 least one team from any public K-12 school, and are held at a
21 public school or university property shall accept cash as a
22 form of payment along with any other form of payment of the
23 event organizer's choosing for admission to the event.

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
25 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
26 otherwise becoming law.
