House Bill 1 as passed the House of Representatives makes a supplemental appropriation of federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act – Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, in the amount of \$1,060,181,797.72. This bill provides that these funds may be delegated as follows:

- 1) Up to \$339,175,000 to support the delivery of health care and related services to citizens of Alabama related to the coronavirus pandemic;
- 2) Up to \$660 million for eligible water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure investments;
- 3) Up to \$55 million for eligible programs or services in response to the negative economic impacts of the public health emergency;
- 4) Up to \$5,000,000 for response and mitigation expenses related to the coronavirus pandemic;
- 5) Up to \$1,006,797.72 to reimburse costs for the administration, auditing, and reporting requirements of the state fiscal recovery funds.

Additionally, this bill provides that any amount of the funds appropriated remaining unexpended on September 30, 2023, shall be reappropriated for the same purposes for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2023, and for all fiscal years thereafter extending through December 31, 2026.
