8 COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA ON WINNING THE  
9 2009 SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.

11 WHEREAS, Alabama's spectacular 32-13 victory over  
12 top-ranked University of Florida in the Southeastern  
13 Conference Football Championship marked its 22nd Southeastern  
14 Conference Football title, and made for a perfect ending to  
15 the Tide's 2009 regular season; and

16 WHEREAS, in beating the then number one ranked  
17 Florida, the Tide secured a spot in the BCS National  
18 Championship Game against the University of Texas; and

19 WHEREAS, in addition to finishing the regular season  
20 undefeated, the Tide also had the distinction of having a  
21 member bring home the school's first Heisman Trophy, six  
22 players receiving Associated Press All-American honors, three  
23 players named Sporting News Freshman All-SEC, a player winning  
24 the 2009 Butkus and Jack Lambert awards, and a coach winning  
25 the Broyles award; and

1                   WHEREAS, the University of Alabama's outstanding  
2 season was accomplished under the leadership of Head Coach  
3 Nick Saban; now therefore,

4                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
5 HOUSES CONCURRING THEREOF, That in recognition of outstanding  
6 performance and accomplishment, and as the 2009 Southeastern  
7 Conference Football Champions, we hereby most highly commend  
8 the Alabama Crimson Tide, and do further direct that copies of  
9 this resolution be provided for appropriate presentation and  
10 display at the University of Alabama.
