8 COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA ON WINNING THE  
9 2009 BCS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

11 WHEREAS, the University of Alabama's spectacular  
12 37-21 victory over the University of Texas in the 2009 BCS  
13 National Championship Game, marked its 13th National Football  
14 Championship, and made for a perfect ending to the Tide's  
15 flawless 2009 Football season; and

16 WHEREAS, Alabama was also voted the unanimous No. 1  
17 in The Associated Press college football poll, earning its  
18 seventh AP title; and

19 WHEREAS, in addition to winning the 2009 BCS  
20 National Championship Game, the Tide finished the regular  
21 season undefeated, and had the distinction of having a member  
22 bring home the school's first Heisman Trophy, six players  
23 receiving Associated Press All-American honors, three players  
24 named Sporting News Freshman All-SEC, a player winning the  
25 2009 Butkus and Jack Lambert awards, and an assistant coach  
26 winning the Broyles award; and

1                   WHEREAS, the University of Alabama's outstanding  
2 season was accomplished under the leadership of Head Coach  
3 Nick Saban; now therefore,

4                   BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
5 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of outstanding  
6 performance and accomplishment, in capturing the 2009 National  
7 Championship, and earning the right to be proclaimed the  
8 number one football team in the nation, we hereby most highly  
9 commend the Alabama Crimson Tide, and do further direct that  
10 copies of this resolution be provided for appropriate  
11 presentation and display at the University of Alabama.
