2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,

3 COMMENDING THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA ON WINNING THE
4 2009 BCS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

5

6 WHEREAS, the University of Alabama's spectacular
7 37-21 victory over the University of Texas in the 2009 BCS
8 National Championship Game, marked its 13th National Football
9 Championship, and made for a perfect ending to the Tide's
10 flawless 2009 Football season; and

11 WHEREAS, Alabama was also voted the unanimous No. 1
12 in The Associated Press college football poll, earning its
13 seventh AP title; and

14 WHEREAS, in addition to winning the 2009 BCS
15 National Championship Game, the Tide finished the regular
16 season undefeated, and had the distinction of having a member
17 bring home the school's first Heisman Trophy, six players
18 receiving Associated Press All-American honors, three players
19 named Sporting News Freshman All-SEC, a player winning the
20 2009 Butkus and Jack Lambert awards, and an assistant coach
21 winning the Broyles award; and

22 WHEREAS, the University of Alabama's outstanding
23 season was accomplished under the leadership of Head Coach
24 Nick Saban; now therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
2 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of outstanding
3 performance and accomplishment, in capturing the 2009 National
4 Championship, and earning the right to be proclaimed the
5 number one football team in the nation, we hereby most highly
6 commend the Alabama Crimson Tide, and do further direct that
7 copies of this resolution be provided for appropriate
8 presentation and display at the University of Alabama.
