8 Pensacola Beach in Florida and The Messenger in Gadsden,

12 to the principles of the Democratic Party; Dr. Bryant was
13 elected and attended seven national Democratic Conventions;
14 she was elected secretary of the Alabama Delegation, has
15 served on the State Democratic Executive Committee Board, and
