9 Earnhardt, Jr., the fulfillment of a dream; and

10 WHEREAS, in her 93rd year, much of her time is spent
11 planning the week-long Fifth Swinford Family Reunion, as well
12 as continuing her hobbies of embroidery, quilting, and yard
13 work; she is also a member of the Red Hat Society and is a
14 bright star at the Senior Center in Munford; with her physical
15 and mental dexterity, Mrs. Swinford remains an inspiration to
16 all those who are privileged to know her; now therefore,
