14 WHEREAS, Mr. Jones has announced his retirement from
15 his position with the School Superintendents of Alabama (SSA)
16 as Coordinator for the Mentor Program for New Superintendents,

18 distinguished tenure as Superintendent of Troy City Schools;

6 Conference, in addition to holding Executive Coaching and New
7 Superintendent meetings throughout the state; and

9 Mr. Jones has earned widespread respect for his tireless
10 commitment and exceptional skills; now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
12 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Hank Jones is honored and
13 commended for his many years of dedicated service to
14 education, and this resolution is offered in highest tribute
