8 URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO FULLY FUND THE
9 RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

11 WHEREAS, the Resource Conservation and Development
12 (RCD) Program is funded in the Natural Resources Conservation
13 Service (NRCS) budget of the United States Department of
14 Agriculture; and

15 WHEREAS, the RCD Program establishes RCD Councils
16 which are the leadership of locally led initiatives; and

17 WHEREAS, RCD Council members are volunteers and
18 include local, civil, appointed, and elected officials; and

19 WHEREAS, RCD Councils are non-profit entities which
20 meet otherwise unmet needs in local communities; and

21 WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2011 Administration Budget
22 eliminates the RCD Program; and

23 WHEREAS, the Alabama Senate recognizes the
24 invaluable service provided by RCD Councils and the important
25 role RCD Councils play in rural and urban development as well
26 as natural resource conservation; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we urge the U.S. Congress to
support full funding of the RCD Program in the 2011 fiscal
year budget and each fiscal year budget thereafter so that the
vital services of the Resource Conservation and Development
Program will continue.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That a copy of this resolution be provided to each member of the Alabama Congressional Delegation as an indication of our strong sentiment and commitment on this issue, and to specifically urge the delegation to vigorously advocate this issue with their Congressional colleagues.
