3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF COMMISIONER ELIJAH SHAW, III.

5 WHEREAS, it is with an inconsolable sense of loss
6 that news is received of the untimely death of a distinguished
7 civic leader, Commissioner Elijah "Tracy" Shaw, III, at the
8 age of 53 years; and

9 WHEREAS, born December 28, 1956, he served with
10 dedication and effectiveness as Commissioner of District Four
11 in Wilcox County; and

12 WHEREAS, elected in November 1990, he was senior
13 member of the Commission in years of service, and had served
14 as Chairman from November 2008 until his death; and

15 WHEREAS, he was also highly regarded as a
16 businessman, the owner of Central Alabama Bus Lines and of
17 Shaw's Service Station; in both his governmental service and
18 business roles, he was respected as fair and straightforward
19 in his dealings with others; and

20 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his beloved
21 wife, Clara Shaw; and children, Rebecca Shaw, Ellis Shaw,
22 Elijah L. Shaw, Clay Shaw, and Elexis Shaw; and

23 WHEREAS, Commissioner Shaw was a highly valued
24 member of the community whose presence will be greatly missed

1 by those who were privileged to know him during the brief span
2 of his life; now therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
4 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the untimely death of
5 Commissioner Elijah Shaw, III, is recorded with deep sadness,
6 and this resolution is offered in tribute to his life of
7 achievement and service, along with heartfelt sympathy to his
