6 WHEREAS, the Alabama Legislature, the Alabama Sports  
7 Festival, and the Governor's Commission on Physical Fitness,  
8 take great pride in continuing the "Honoring Our Heroes"  
9 program, a salute to all Alabama's teachers and educational  
10 support personnel who have served, taught, and influenced  
11 Alabama's children, and who continue to do so; and

12 WHEREAS, the Alabama Sports Festival, a nonprofit  
13 organization, held its first Alabama Summer Olympic Games in  
14 1983, and will celebrate its 28th Anniversary in 2010; and in  
15 keeping with its philosophy of instilling Academic Excellence  
16 and Good Citizenship to the youth of Alabama, having awarded  
17 some \$200,000 in academic scholarships, the organization  
18 adamantly opposes drug and alcohol use, instills ethical
