2 wife, Judy Rushton; two sons and daughters-in-law, Nelson and
3 Vivian Rushton, and Reese and Kimberly Rushton; two cherished
4 grandchildren, Benjamin and Zachary Rushton; and a brother,
5 Dan Rushton; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Rushton loved American history and his
7 students, for whom he was a combination of hero, role model,
8 and mentor, consistently going beyond the call of duty to have
9 a positive impact on the many lives he touched; through the
10 years, Mr. Rushton taught life lessons as well as history, and
11 he gave the gift of confidence to the students he motivated to
12 achieve their full potential; although his presence will be
13 greatly missed, his memory will live on in the lives of those
14 who were privileged to have him as a teacher and friend; now
