11 news is received of the untimely death of a distinguished  
12 civic leader, Mr. Bradley E. Jones, on February 17, 2010, at  
13 the age of 40 years; and

14 WHEREAS, in the death of Mr. Jones, his loving  
15 family, many friends, and the entire community have suffered  
16 an inconsolable loss; and

17 WHEREAS, a former resident of Huntsville, Mr. Jones  
18 was senior vice president and division president for Health  
19 Management Associates of Naples, Florida; he had previously  
20 served as CEO of Crestwood Medical Center and was a former  
21 chairman of the Huntsville/Madison County Chamber of Commerce,  
22 earning widespread respect for his commitment and  
23 effectiveness; a highlight of his career was his determined  
24 pursuit of a new 60-bed hospital in Madison; and

25 WHEREAS, born in Bristol, Tennessee, he earned a  
26 Bachelor's Degree in Public Administration from Virginia Tech,  
27 where he a played football and participated in extracurricular

1 activities including the German Club; later he earned a  
2 Master's Degree in Health Finance and Health Policy from Johns  
3 Hopkins University; and

4 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his devoted  
5 wife of 15 years, Deborah Jones; daughter, Anna Katherine  
6 Jones; son, Burke Hamilton Jones; and mother, Bonnie Jones;  
7 along with many additional caring relatives, colleagues, and  
8 friends, and two godchildren; and

9 WHEREAS, a man who exemplified leadership, Mr. Jones  
10 was both esteemed and beloved, inspiring those with whom he  
11 worked to do their best; his contributions to the community  
12 were numerous and far-reaching, and while his presence will be  
13 greatly missed, his legacy of service will endure for future  
14 generations; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF  
16 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the untimely death of Mr.
