5 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow and regret that
6 news is received of the death of Mr. Ira M. Hill of Anniston,
7 Alabama, on January 23, 2010; at the age of 87 years; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was well-known and admired in the
9 area, having been a highly regarded businessman, the owner of
10 Hill's Moving and Storage Company in the early 1950s and
11 Hill's Service Company in the 1970s; and

12 WHEREAS, a resident of Anniston since the late
13 1940s, he grew up in Gadsden and attended Emma Sansom High
14 School, where he was a standout basketball player; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was a longtime member of the First
16 United Methodist Church, the Anniston Country Club, and the
17 Anniston Quarterback Club; he was an avid golfer and belonged
18 to the Alabama Seniors Golf Association and the Southern
19 Seniors Golf Association; and

20 WHEREAS, he leaves to mourn his death his devoted
21 wife of 67 years, Genevieve C. Hill; daughter, Betty Fletcher
22 Hill Jackson, and husband, Robert; sister, Marie Hall, and
23 husband, George; sister-in-law, Betty Holdsambeck, and
24 husband, Wendell; and several nieces and nephews; and

1 WHEREAS, preceding him in death were his parents,
2 Annie Bell and Hugh Hill; brothers, Claude Hill and Bill Hill;
3 and sister, Marguerite Harris; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill was a valued member of the
5 community whose presence will be greatly missed by those who
6 were privileged to know him during his long and productive
7 life; now therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
9 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the death of Mr. Ira M. Hill
10 is recorded with deep sadness, and by copy of this resolution,
11 heartfelt sympathy is extended to his grieving family.
