12 Taylor of Birmingham, Alabama, on February 15, 2010, at the

18 Brook High School who planned to attend college after  
19 graduation; he was active in extracurricular organizations

22 Team and had traveled to several tournaments including the  
23 Wake Forest Tournament, where he won first place in the Junior  
24 Varsity Lincoln-Douglas Debate rounds; in addition, he was an  
25 Eagle Scout in Troop 28, where he had served in numerous  
26 leadership positions; and

1                   WHEREAS, he sang in the Westminster Choir and was a  
2 faithful member of Independent Presbyterian Church, where he  
3 was an acolyte and was active in the youth group, serving on  
4 the Youth Subcommittee and the Search Committee for the  
5 Assistant Youth Director; and

6                   WHEREAS, he is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs.  
7 George M. Taylor, III; brother, George Malcolm Taylor, IV;  
8 sisters, Lottice Howell Taylor and Emma Bolling Hall Taylor;  
9 he is also survived by his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Harry C.  
10 Howell, Jr., and Mrs. George M. Taylor; and by Miss LuVenia
