8 COMMENDING MUSCLE SHOALS POLICE LIEUTENANT CLINT
9 RECK ON HIS NOMINATION FOR THE AMERICA'S MOST WANTED ALL-STAR

12 WHEREAS, we note with great pride that Lieutenant
13 Clint Reck of the Muscle Shoals Police Department has been
14 nominated as an America's Most Wanted All-Star; and

15 WHEREAS, recognizing a need among mostly small or
16 rural law enforcement departments that cannot afford adequate
17 numbers of bulletproof vests for their officers, Lieutenant
18 Reck, with the assistance of members of Parkway Baptist
19 Church, which he attends, and a colleague, became involved in
20 the Armor of God project; and

21 WHEREAS, the Armor of God project, which began in
22 April 2009, provides donated bulletproof vests to those
23 departments that cannot afford the vests; since its inception,
24 the project has shipped nearly 800 vests, which are
25 accompanied by Christian literature, to departments in the
26 United States, Costa Rica, Guatemala, and the Philippines; and

1 WHEREAS, balloting for the America's Most Wanted
2 All-Star award is open to the public and will conclude on
3 April 16, 2010; and

4 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Reck has given selflessly of his
5 time and resources for the greater good; his contributions can
6 be measured in lives saved among law enforcement officers; now
7 therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
9 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we heartily commend
10 Lieutenant Clint Reck of the Muscle Shoals Police Department
11 on his nomination for an America's Most Wanted All-Star award
12 and that, by copy of this resolution we extend our sincere
13 gratitude for his service to the people of Alabama and to his
14 fellow officers.
