9 TEAM FOR WINNING THE CLASS 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

12 the members of the Hoover High School Girls Basketball Team
13 are congratulated for winning the Class 6A State Championship
14 with a 39-19 victory over Bob Jones High School; and
