12 contributions that John M. Wynn has made to Central Alabama

15 degree from Mississippi College and an M.Ed. degree from
16 Auburn University, Mr. Wynn began his career in public
17 education at Moss Point High School in Moss Point,

19 Alexander City Junior College in 1966; and

21 literature courses, Mr. Wynn introduced World Literature to
22 ACJC; among his many other pioneering contributions to the
23 college, he created the "Alexian" yearbook and the school's
24 newspaper, "The Alexian Times," and founded the Youth College

1 WHEREAS, since his retirement, Mr. Wynn has served
2 as Evening Program Supervisor in the office of the Dean of
3 Instruction, earning the nickname, "Dean of Darkness"; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Wynn is to be commended for
5 long-standing and continuing dedication to CACC and the
6 Alexander City community; now therefore,
