7 commendations and congratulations are extended to an
8 outstanding young Alabamian, Thomas Alexander "T. A." Sluis,
9 on his success in the 2010 Montgomery County Spelling Bee; and

10 WHEREAS, a fifth grader at Trinity Presbyterian
11 School, he won the privilege of representing Trinity
12 Presbyterian School after competing against 23 other students
13 in grades five through eight, the first time a fifth grader
14 had won the school contest and progressed to the county level;

16 WHEREAS, he studied words of Latin, Greek, Spanish,
17 German, Asian, Dutch, Arabic, and other origins for more than
18 30 hours during the weeks before the contests, and his hard
19 work was rewarded when he finished sixth among approximately
20 30 participants; and

22 newfangled, androcentric, rouge, sayonara, and alliteration,
23 before falling victim to salmonella, the word that eluded him;

1 WHEREAS, his impressive achievement at such a young
2 age bodes well for the future, and his loyal supporters look
3 forward to next year's competition; with his keen intellect
4 and commitment to excellence, Thomas Alexander Sluis is the
5 source of justifiable pride to his family, the school, and the
6 entire community; now therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
8 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Thomas Alexander Sluis is
9 honored and commended upon his success in the 2010 Montgomery
