3 COMMENDING JOHN YANCEY KEY ON ATTAINING THE RANK OF
4 EAGLE SCOUT IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

6 WHEREAS, highest commendation is extended to John
7 Yancey Key of Walnut Grove, on attaining the rank of Eagle
8 Scout, the most advanced rank in the Boy Scouts of America;

10 WHEREAS, the Eagle Scout Award, earned by only a
11 small percentage of Scouts, involves the completion of an
12 Eagle Project and represents many years of diligence in
13 pursuit of a worthy goal that brings honor to the Scout, his
14 family, and his troop; and

15 WHEREAS, a member of Troop 50 of West Etowah County,
16 John Yancey Key has progressed through the levels of Scouting
17 from Cub Scout to Eagle Scout, meeting the demanding
18 requirements for achieving this coveted award; in addition to
19 completing an Eagle Project, an Eagle Scout must earn many
20 Merit Badges as evidence of mastery in various Scouting
21 skills, and must strive to conduct himself with honor,
22 loyalty, courage, cheer, and service, the five integral
23 responsibilities of a Scout; and

24 WHEREAS, in addition to achieving the rank of Eagle
25 Scout, John Yancey Key has earned 43 merit badges and has been

1 the recipient of numerous awards, including the Hometown USA
2 Award and the Good Turn for America Award for service to the
3 community;

4 WHEREAS, John Yancey Key is a graduate of West End
5 High School who is presently attending Jacksonville State
6 University on a Leadership Scholarship; he is the son of
7 Michael and Pam Key and grandson of Kenneth and Carla Key, Roy
8 and Virginia Cash, and the late Joe Stancil and Judy Key; and

9 WHEREAS, through the years John Yancey Key has
10 exhibited those hard-won characteristics of trustworthiness,
11 self-discipline, and good citizenship, all components of the
12 Scouting program; with the guidance and support of his
13 Scouting leaders, he has earned the esteem of his community,
14 fellow Scouts, and all Alabamians; now therefore,

15 BE IT RESOLVED OF THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
16 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of his
17 outstanding achievement in attaining the prestigious rank of
18 Eagle Scout, John Yancey Key is highly commended, and this
