5 RECOGNIZING CHIROPRACTIC CARE AS AN EFFECTIVE METHOD

8 WHEREAS, nearly 50% of patients in the United States
9 who suffer from persistent back pain seek chiropractic care;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, a preponderance of peer-reviewed scientific
12 literature suggests that chiropractic care, including spinal
13 manipulation and mobilization, is at least as effective as a
14 treatment for patients with back and neck pain as other widely
15 used methods; and

16 WHEREAS, a 2009 expert study from Harvard University
17 and Mercer Health and Benefits reports that spine-related
18 problems, including back and neck pain, which are extremely
19 common conditions and consume large amounts of medical and
20 health care resources in the United States, account for an
21 estimated \$85 billion in annual spending; and

22 WHEREAS, the 2009 study further finds that
23 chiropractic care is very effective for treating lower back
24 and neck pain; according to the study, when considering the
25 relative effectiveness of treatment in conjunction with the

1 actual cost of treatment, chiropractic care provides excellent
2 value, when compared to medical physician care; and

3 WHEREAS, the 2009 study projects that insurance
4 coverage for chiropractic care for lower back and neck pain,
5 excluding conditions involving fracture or malignancy, is
6 likely to improve the cost-effectiveness of care in the United
7 States and the improvement is likely to occur within a very
8 short timeframe; now therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize
11 chiropractic care as a viable and cost-effective method for
12 the treatment of back and neck pain.
