8 COMMENDING REBECCA GILBREATH CRUMPTON UPON HER
9 EXEMPLARY LIFETIME OF ACHIEVEMENT.

11 WHEREAS, it is a pleasure to extend the highest
12 commendation to Rebecca Gilbreath Crumpton, called Becky by
13 those who love her, in recognition of her outstanding record
14 of achievement as a student, an educator, and mentor for so
15 many children from Winston County High School; and

16 WHEREAS, Ms. Crumpton, a native of Double Springs,
17 is a 1954 graduate from Winston County High School where, as a
18 student, she served as Beta Club President, yearbook editor,
19 captain of the cheerleaders, as well as many other activities;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, after graduating from high school, she
22 attended The University of Alabama receiving her BS degree in
23 Mathematics in 1956 and in 1965, she received her Master's in
24 Mathematics from Florence State College, now known as the
25 University of North Alabama; and

26 WHEREAS, Ms. Crumpton began her teaching career in
27 1957 at Haleyville High School and then returned to her Alma

1 Mater at Double Springs in 1961 to start a math department
2 that offered all math courses to the students in order to
3 prepare them for college; and

4 WHEREAS, Ms. Crumpton's guidance as senior class
5 sponsor was pivotal in the lives of the students from the
6 Class of 1965 at Winston County High School, where her
7 responsibilities included yearbook sponsor, cheerleader
8 sponsor, Beta Club sponsor, bus driver for the basketball,
9 volleyball, softball teams, and the band; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Crumpton continued to teach at Winston
11 County High School until her retirement in 1997 accumulating
12 41 years as a career teacher; and

13 WHEREAS, after retirement, she has maintained her
14 involvement in her school and community by working with the
15 Scholar's Bowl, and teaching weekly GED classes; and

16 WHEREAS, devoted to faith and family, Ms. Crumpton
17 is a member of the First Baptist Church of Double Springs
18 where she sings in the choir, teaches Vacation Bible School,
19 and devotes her time to building missions; she has used her
20 construction skills as a master at sheetrock on numerous trips
21 to many places, including South Africa, where she has traveled
22 four times; and for her missionary work, Ms. Crumpton was
23 recognized by the Alabama Baptists in 2008 as the Alabama
24 Baptist Volunteer Missionary of the Year; and

25 WHEREAS, through her life, Becky has earned the
26 widespread respect for her exceptional abilities and tireless
27 dedication; now therefore,

3 recognize Ms. Rebecca Gilbreath Crumpton for her tireless
