3 MOURNING THE DEATH OF DR. ADRIEL JOHNSON.

5 WHEREAS, it is with a profound sense of sorrow that
6 we note the tragic and untimely passing of Dr. Adriel Johnson
7 at the age of 52 years; and

8 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson was an associate professor of
9 biology at the University of Alabama - Huntsville, where he
10 specialized in cell biology and nutritional physiology
11 research; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson's commitment to education
13 extended beyond his professional duties; he gave countless
14 hours volunteering with the First Missionary Baptist Church
15 Boy Scout troop, teaching Scouts about nature and science; for
16 his efforts, he was honored with the Boy Scout district award
17 of merit, the Whitney Young Award for exceptional work with
18 urban and rural Scouts, and the Silver Beaver, the highest
19 honor available to a volunteer Scout leader; and

20 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson was a respected member of the
21 university community with a reputation as a dedicated
22 instructor with a positive demeanor; he was involved with the
23 Minority Graduate Student Association and was known as a
24 mentor to minority students; and

1 WHEREAS, a beloved father and husband, Dr. Johnson
2 is survived by his wife, Jacquelyn; and two sons, Adriel, Jr.,
3 and Jeriel; and

4 WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson's passing is a great loss to
5 his family and to members of the community who remember him as
6 a man who gave of himself and asked nothing in return; now
7 therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
9 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That the life of Dr. Adriel Johnson
10 is hereby celebrated in this special tribute and that, by copy
11 of this resolution, we extend our heartfelt condolences to his
