4 TEAM FOR WINNING THE CLASS 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

6 WHEREAS, it is with great pride and pleasure that  
7 the members of the Hoover High School Girls Basketball Team  
8 are congratulated for winning the Class 6A State Championship  
9 with a 39-19 victory over Bob Jones High School; and

10 WHEREAS, in capturing the title, the Hoover High  
11 School Lady Bucs set an AHSAA record for holding a team to the  
12 lowest point total in the history of the State Tournament; and

13 WHEREAS, averaging an impressive 65 points per game,  
14 Hoover High School's record for the season was 32-1, and the  
15 loss was by only six points to the No. 1 team in the nation,  
16 St. Mary's from California; en route to the 2010 championship,  
17 the Lady Bucs won a series of tournaments: the 6A NE Regional,  
18 the Oak Ridge, Tennessee, Tournament, and the Hoover Big  
19 Orange Classic; a highlight of the season was when senior  
20 Tyrese Tanner scored her 1,000th career point; and

22 not only the exceptional performance of the team members, but  
23 also the experience, dedication, and leadership provided by  
24 Head Coach Donnie Quinn and Assistant Coaches Jan Holcomb,  
25 Krystle Johnson, George Minoso, and Kim Cook; and

2 teamwork all season long, and their accomplishments reflect  
3 honor upon their families and their loyal supporters,  
4 including Hoover High School Principal Don Hulin, Athletic

6                   WHEREAS, with every game played in the spirit and  
7 tradition of good sportsmanship and fair play, each member of  
8 the Hoover High School Girls Basketball Team is deserving of  
9 highest praise for her integral part in winning the coveted
