4 STATE TREE FARMERS OF THE YEAR.

6           WHEREAS, it is a pleasure to extend commendations  
7 and congratulations to Salem and Dianne Saloom of Brewton on  
8 being selected the 2009 Alabama State Tree Farmers of the  
9 Year; and

10           WHEREAS, the Salooms are recognized for their good  
11 stewardship of the 1,762 acres they own in Conecuh County;  
12 they have applied the advice that they sought and received  
13 from State agencies, including an excellent prescribed burning  
14 program with Dr. Saloom as the certified burn manager; and

15           WHEREAS, the property includes a three-room cabin  
16 that the Salooms built primarily from the site's timber  
17 resources, and there are well-maintained roads to benefit  
18 timber and wildlife management; a recent addition to the  
19 property is a newly fenced pasture for horses, and horseback  
20 riding is a favorite mode of transportation; and

21           WHEREAS, an avid turkey hunter, Dr. Saloom also has  
22 an exemplary wildlife program, planting sawtooth oaks and plum  
23 and persimmon trees to attract wildlife; in addition,  
24 bluebird, wood duck, and martin boxes have been erected; there  
25 is also a population of gopher tortoises; and

1               WHEREAS, water quality on the property is superior;  
2               the pond near the cabin is well-maintained and provides a  
3               great fishing spot as well as a beautiful view; and

4               WHEREAS, the Salooms, along with their son, Patrick,  
5               have generously shared their property through the years,  
6               providing a retreat for friends, family, and church groups as  
7               well as providing educational opportunities by hosting local  
8               school groups, including the annual Classroom in the Forest  
9               for fifth graders; now therefore,

10              BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH  
11              HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Salem and Dianne Saloom are  
12              honored and commended for their outstanding achievement in  
13              being named 2009 Alabama State Tree Farmers of the Year, and  
14              this resolution is offered in highest tribute to them along  
15              with heartiest congratulations and best wishes for continuing  
16              success.
