7 of the central nervous system, Multiple Sclerosis (MS)
8 disrupts the flow of information between an individual's body
9 and brain; and

10 WHEREAS, MS affects an estimated 2.5 million people
11 worldwide, 400,000 in the United States, and 4,000 people in
12 Alabama; and

13 WHEREAS, often first diagnosed in individuals aged
14 20-50, MS is the most common neurological disease leading to
15 disability in young adults; and

16 WHEREAS, during March 8-12, 2010, the National MS
17 Society will sponsor MS Awareness Week in the State of
18 Alabama; and

19 WHEREAS, the Alabama Chapter of the National MS
20 Society will hold events across the state to support the
21 observance of MS Awareness Week; now therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
23 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That March 8-12, 2010, is
24 recognized as Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Week, and by copy
25 of this resolution for appropriate display, the citizens of
