7 and former colleague, H.L. "Sonny" Callahan, has been named

22 Alabama's interests ever to serve in the Congress of the
23 United States; and

25 House, Congressman Callahan returned to Mobile, where he

1 opened the consulting firm, Sonny Callahan and Associates; his
2 inimitable charm and easy-going competence inevitably led him
3 to success in this venture, as in all his previous endeavors;

5 WHEREAS, Congressman Callahan's record of service
6 and devotion to the City of Mobile, to Alabama's First
7 Congressional District, and to the entire State of Alabama is
8 unsurpassed in the history of public service in our State; now
9 therefore,

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
11 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we heartily congratulate the
