13 Juran, who served for 25 years as a law enforcement officer

17 thereafter was promoted to Trooper where he continued to serve  
18 for nine years at the Decatur State Trooper Post; and

20 county of Jefferson County where he served until 2005; during  
21 his assignment to the Birmingham Post, Trooper Juran became a  
22 member of the Department's Honor Guard Team, and also served  
23 as a member of the Department's Special Operations; and

24 WHEREAS, in March of 2005, Trooper Juran was  
25 promoted to the rank of Corporal and upon transfer, served at  
26 the Tuscaloosa Post until his return to Jefferson County where  
27 he served until his retirement in 2010; and

1                   WHEREAS, during his career as an Alabama State  
2 Trooper, he was honored to escort Coach Watson Brown and the  
3 UAB Blazers Football Team, Governor Guy Hunt, members of the  
4 Black Caucus, the Former United States Secretary of Labor  
5 Elaine Chao, and numerous dignitaries throughout the state;

8 as a State Trooper were recognized by numerous awards
