11 WHEREAS, the young people of Alabama are the leaders
12 of tomorrow; and

13 WHEREAS, many young people are in need of
14 professional youth services to help them achieve their full
15 potential; and

16 WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Clubs in Alabama provide
17 programs in character and leadership development, health and
18 life skills, education and career development, the arts, and
19 sports and recreation; and

20 WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Clubs in Alabama provide
21 a positive place for youth by instilling a sense of
22 competence, usefulness, and belonging; and

23 WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Clubs National Youth of
24 the Year Program is designed to promote and recognize service
25 to the Club and the community, academic performance, and
26 contributions to family and spiritual life; and

1 WHEREAS, there are 114 Boys and Girls Clubs in the
2 State of Alabama representing 22 organizations that provide
3 services to 128,000 youths each year; and

4 WHEREAS, the week of March 21 through March 27 is
5 recognized nationally as Boys and Girls Clubs Week; now
6 therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
8 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby recognize and
9 commend the Alabama Boys and Girls Clubs Youth of the Year
10 candidates and all of the youth throughout the State of
11 Alabama who participated in this worthwhile initiative and
12 that we recognize the significant role the Club staff and
13 volunteers play in shaping the lives of these youths.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That March 30, 2010, is
15 declared Boys and Girls Clubs Day at the Alabama Capitol.
