10 retiring March 31, 2010, from her position as manager of the  
11 Berachah Gym, where she has earned widespread esteem for her  
12 exceptional abilities and tireless dedication since the city  
13 acquired the gym in 1987; and

14 WHEREAS, on September 1, 1960, Nellie Pike agreed to  
15 teach a women's "Slimnastics" class for the City of  
16 Huntsville, and the ensuing years have been devoted to her  
17 passion for exercise and recreation; among her  
18 accomplishments, she started Huntsville's first volleyball  
19 league for women, served on the state physical fitness board,  
20 and directed the popular men's basketball league for 25 years;

23 Monrovia, Alabama, Nellie Pike developed a strong work ethic  
24 that has served her well during a remarkable career that has  
25 spanned six Huntsville Mayors and 11 United States Presidents;

2 slowing down; and

3 WHEREAS, although she is well-known for her  
4 strictness and attention to every detail as she presides over  
5 activities at the Berachah Gym, Nellie Pike is also admired  
6 for her generosity to those in need; over the course of five  
7 decades, she has become one of the city's most beloved and  
8 valued employees, and she will be greatly missed; now
