6 WHEREAS, we note with great appreciation that the
7 City of Talladega, Alabama, will hold a gala observance of its
8 175th Anniversary, March 25 to March 28, 2010; and

9 WHEREAS, incorporated on January 9, 1835, Talladega
10 is one of the most historic and nationally recognizable
11 municipalities in the State of Alabama; from its history of
12 pivotal Indian confrontations to its modern-day notoriety for
13 world-class NASCAR racing, Talladega has contributed greatly
14 to the rich history of our State; it is home to Alabama's
15 oldest continuously operating bank, Alabama's oldest
16 continuously operating courthouse, and Alabama's oldest
17 historically African-American liberal arts college, Talladega
18 College; and

19 WHEREAS, among dozens of exciting attractions and
20 events, the four-day celebration will feature a play depicting
21 significant events in Talladega's history, written, produced,
22 and directed by members of the Talladega High School Drama
23 Club, as well as concert performances by a number of native
24 Alabamian musicians, including Bo Bice and Ruben Studdard; a

1 parade will be held in honor of the USCAA Women's and Men's
2 National Champion Basketball Teams from Talladega College; and

4 and quality of life of the entire State of Alabama are

6 observance of this historic milestone; now therefore,
