ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
RECOGNIZING THE GEORGE LINDSEY UNIVERSITY OF NORTH
ALABAMA FILM FESTIVAL WITH ITS THEME "BACK TO THE FUTURE."

WHEREAS, the 13th Annual George Lindsey University
of North Alabama Film Festival will be highlighted by a
celebration of the 25th Anniversary of "Back to the Future,"
featuring special guest Lea Thompson, an award-winning
actress, producer, and director; and

WHEREAS, Lea Thompson is well-known for appearing in
the "Back to the Future" trilogy and will be joined at the
film festival by writer and producer Bob Gale; and

WHEREAS, her appearance at the 2010 festival will be
a return visit to North Alabama for Lea Thompson, who spent
six weeks in Huntsville in 1986 filming the hit movie "Space
Camp"; her notable career accomplishments include starring in
the series "Caroline in the City" and numerous additional
credits in television, theatre, and movies; and

WHEREAS, the George Lindsey UNA Film Festival was
founded in 1998 by the celebrated actor and entertainer, a
loyal UNA alumnus who may be most widely known for his role as
Goober on the "Andy Griffith Show"; and

WHEREAS, a native Alabamian, George Lindsey is an
international star, and his credits include stage and movie

1 roles along with television episodes of "Twilight Zone," "The
2 Alfred Hitchcock Hour," "Gunsmoke," and "M.A.S.H." among many
3 others; and

4 WHEREAS, throughout his professional life, he has
5 remained active in charitable and cultural events in Alabama,
6 including establishing the George Lindsey Academic
7 Scholarships at his alma mater; and

8 WHEREAS, the nationally acclaimed film festival,
9 which is held annually on the UNA campus in Florence, is one
10 of only a few similar events in the United States that are
11 presented in a university setting, providing attendees with an
12 outstanding lineup of free workshops, panels, quality film
13 screenings, networking opportunities, and informal interaction
14 among filmmakers and guests; this year's festival celebrating
15 the 25th Anniversary of "Back to the Future" is scheduled for
16 March 4-7, 2010, and is being cosponsored by BTTF.com; now
17 therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
19 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That it is a great pleasure to
20 recognize and commend the 2010 George Lindsey University of
21 North Alabama Film Festival with its theme of "Back to the
