16 maintained their time-honored tradition of volunteering to
17 serve the community and build good citizenship; and

18 WHEREAS, among the many worthy organizations that
19 benefit from the support of the Tuscumbia Civitan Club are:
20 the American Legion Boys State/Girls State, the Cerebral Palsy
21 Telethon, the Court Appointed Special Advocates, the Colbert
22 Caring Center, the Helen Keller Library, Meals on Wheels,
23 Rolling Riders, the Seed Project, and Safe Place; in addition
24 to assisting with the Junior Civitan Club at Deshler High
25 School; for many years, the Civitan Club also has sponsored

1 and organized the Annual Downtown Christmas Parade in
2 Tuscumbia; and

3 WHEREAS, the good works of the Tuscumbia Civitan
4 Club are supported through annual fund-raising projects
5 including the sale of Historical Christmas Ornaments featuring
6 local landmarks, the Helen Keller Festival Spaghetti Supper,
7 the Vidalia Onion Sale, the Annual Yard Sale, and fruitcake
8 sales at Christmas through local grocery stores; membership
9 dues and donations also contribute to the valued Civitan
10 projects; now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
12 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in recognition of its
13 distinguished history of dedicated community service, the
14 Tuscumbia Civitan Club is honored and commended on the
15 occasion of its 70th Anniversary Dinner/Birthday Party on June
16 3, 2010, and this resolution is offered in highest tribute and
17 deepest appreciation to the club, its members and leaders, on
18 behalf of the citizens of the State of Alabama.
