8 RECOGNIZING THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF SECOND SAINT
9 SILOAM MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH.

11 WHEREAS, we note with pride and appreciation that
12 Second Saint Siloam Missionary Baptist Church in Brewton will
13 observe its 100th anniversary on June 13, 2010; and

14 WHEREAS, on November 5, 1909, approximately 150
15 members of the Second Saint Siloam Missionary Baptist Church
16 assembled in the Congregational Church at the corner of St.
17 Joseph and Evergreen Streets for the purpose of calling a new
18 minister, the late Reverend William Franklin; under Reverend
19 Franklin's pastorate, the Church enjoyed nearly a decade of
20 growth and progress; on June 10, 1910, they dedicated the
21 present location of Second Saint Siloam Missionary Baptist
22 Church; and

23 WHEREAS, over the past 100 years, the Church has
24 been guided by the Reverends Franklin, L.L. Hawthorne, Smith,
25 C.W. Wilson, J.L. Peterson, J. Murphy, J.A. Clausell, R.H.
26 Williams, A.M. Mosley, B.F. Dudley, E.B. Radney, John H.

1 Williams, C.C. Bradley, Herman J. Lancaster, and the present
2 pastor, Reverend Willie James Blue; and

3 WHEREAS, under Reverend Blue's leadership, the
4 Church has striven to achieve his vision of a congregation
5 that will abandon traditional comfort zones and become not a
6 church within a building, but a church within a community,
7 thereby helping to draw people to Christ; and

8 WHEREAS, we are honored by the opportunity to join
9 in this milestone observance; now therefore,

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
11 THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That we hereby recognize the 100th
12 anniversary of the Second Saint Siloam Missionary Baptist
13 Church in Brewton.
